- c) The Special Cover should conform strictly to one of these three sizes: i) 11cm x 22 cm, ii) 13cm x 22 cm & iii) 16cm x 24.3 cm and paper should be Maplithos 176 GSM. The back side of the special cover should contain the logo of Department of Posts and the words "Approved by: the Chief Postmaster General, West Bengal Circle, Department of Posts" (also in Hindi version), with Code No: -WB/36/2021.
- d) Necessary action may be taken as per the existing Rules & Procedures of the Department regarding release of any Special Cover vide "The Handbook on Philately" and instructions issued in this regard time to time. 1000 (One thousand) Special Covers may be supplied to the ADG (Philately), Dak Bhawan, New Delhi as directed vide Directorate letter no.P-46/20/2021-Phil-DOP dated 02.8.2021.



Red Cherry Pepper, locally known as 'Dalle Khursani' in Sikkim, is well known for its unique flavor and high pungency. It is considered as one of the holtest chillies in the world. The crop belongs to the family Solanaceae and genus Capsicum. Plant grows up to 100-130 cm height under open field and 150-180cm height in green house condition. Each plant produces about 2.5-3.0kg fruits with about 500-1000 pods. The crop can be grown round the year under protected condition. Dalle Khursani is almost round cherry size and bright rod when fully ripe. It is also grown in surrounding areas of Dariesling and Kalimpong. In 2021 'Dalle Khursani' was granted the bright red when fully ripe. It is also grown in surrounding areas of Darjeeling and Kalimpong. In 2021 'Dalle Khursani' was granted the Geographical Indication certificate by Government of India. West Bengal Postal Circle would like to celebrate the essence of 'Dalle Khursani' by bringing out a Special Cover on it.

लाल चेरी मिर्च अपनी अनूठी महक एवं तेजी तीखेपन के लिए प्रसिद्ध है जिसे सिक्किम के स्थानीय लोग 'डल्ले खुर्सानी' कहते हैं। यह विश्व की सबसे तीखी मिर्चों में से एक है। यह सोलेनेसी और जीनस कैप्सिकम परिवार का पींचा है। यह पींचा खुले मैदान में 100-130 से मी. ऊंचाई तक और ग्रीन हाउस वातावरण में 150-180से. मी. ऊंचाई तक बढ़ता है। प्रत्येक पींचे में लगभग 2.5 कि. ग्रा. से 3 कि. ग्रा. तक मिर्चे एवं 500-1000 फलियां लगती है। संरक्षित स्थिति में इस फसल की खेती वर्ष भर की जा सकती है। डल्ले खुर्सानी का आकार प्रायः गोल चेरी की तरह होता है और पूरी तरह से पक जाने पर यह चटख लाल रंग की हो जाती है। इसे दार्जिलिंग और कलिम्पोंग के आस-पास के क्षेत्रों में भी उगाया जाता है। उल्ले खुर्<mark>सानी को वर्ष 2021 में</mark> भारत सरकार द्वारा भौगोलिक संकेत प्रमाण-पत्र प्रदान किया गया। पश्चिम बंगाल डाक सर्किल डल्ले खुर्सानी पर एक विशेष आवरण का लोकार्पण करके इसके जायके का जप्रन मनाना चाहता है।
