- c) The Special Cover should conform strictly to one of these three sizes: i) 11cm x 22 cm, ii) 13cm x 22 cm. & iii) 16cm x 24.3 cm and paper should be Maplithos 176 GSM. The back side of the special cover should contain the logo of Department of Posts and the words "Approved by: the Chief Postmaster General, West Bengal Circle, Department of Posts" (also in Hindi version), with Code No: WB/04/2022.
- d) Necessary action may be taken as per the existing Rules & Procedures of the Department regarding release of any Special Cover vide "The Handbook on Philately" and instructions issued in this regard time to time. 1000 (one thousand) Special Covers may be supplied to the ADG (Philately), Dak Bhawan, New Delhi as directed vide letter no. P-46/20/2021-Phil-DOP dated 02.8.2021.

Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav दार्जिलिंग चाय का पौधा (कैमेलिया साइनेन्सिस) एक कठोर, बहु-तनेवाला एवं धीरे-धीरे बढ़ने वाला सदाबहार झाड़ीनुमा पौधा है। इसकी पत्तियां छोटी, चीमड़ गहरे चमकदार हरे रंग की होती हैं जो अक्सर मृदुरोमिल चमकीले रोमशता से ढकी हुई होती है। इसमें प्रचंड सदियों, विस्तारित सूखे और दार्जिलिंग की उच्च ऊँचाई को सहने की क्षमता होती है। इसका दुर्लभ स्वाद दार्जिलिंग पहाड़ियों के लिए अद्वितीय पौधों की जीन, मृदु-रसायन, ऊँचाई, तापमान और वर्षा के संयोजन का परिणाम है। पश्चिम बंगाल के दार्जिलिंग जिले में बगीचों में उगाई और पैदा की जाने वाली चाय में स्वाद, सुगंध और मुख के स्वाद की विशिष्ट और स्वाभाविक रूप से उत्पन्न होने वाली ऑर्गेनोलेप्टिक विशेषताएं होती हैं जिसने विश्वभर के विदेकशील उपभोक्ताओं का संरक्षण और मान्यता हासिल की है। वास्तव में अपनी अनूठी गुणवत्ता और संसाधित विधि के कारण ही वर्ष 2004 में दार्जिलिंग चाय को जीआई टैग प्राप्त हुआ है।

The leaves are small, leathery, dark, glossy green in colour often covered with a downy silvery pubescence. It is able to withstand severe winters, extended droughts and the high altitude of Darjeeling. Its rare flavour is a result of combination of plant genes, soil chemistry, elevations, temperature and rainfall unique to the Darjeeling hills. Tea grown and produced in the gardens in the district of Darjeeling, West Bengal, has the distinctive and naturally occurring organoleptic characteristics of taste, aroma and mouth feet, which have won the patronage and recognition of discerning consumers all over the world. It is indeed for the reason of its unique quality and method of processing of Darjeeling Tea, that it has obtained the GI tag in the year 2004.
