5. In compliance of Hon'ble CAT, Calcutta Bench order dated 13-07-2015 in O.A. No. 694 of 2012, the CRC considered the case of Smt. Chitra Sarkar, D/o Late Ruhini Kanta Sarkar, ex-Gr. D, Coochbehar Dn. died in harness on 01-06-2002 for compassionate appointment. As per the provisions of the scheme for compassionate appointment and FAQ communicated under DOP&T's No. 14014/02/2012-Estt.(D) dated 30-05-2013 a "married daughter" can be considered for compassionate appointment subject to the conditions that she was wholly dependent on the Govt. Servant at the time of his/her death in harness and she must support other dependent members of the family, the CRC observed that Smt. Chitra Sarkar got married on 05-03-2002 whereas ex-employee died in harness on 01-06-2002 i.e.; on the cut off date (the date of death of the deceased official) Smt. Chitra Sarkar was married and as such she was not dependent on the deceased employee as on 01-06-2002. Therefore, the CRC keeping in view the provisions of the compassionate appointment scheme recommends for rejection of the claim for compassionate appointment of Smt. Chitra Sarkar.
