a)The designs of the Special Cover and the Special Cancellation as approved by the competent authority are enclosed herewith and it is permitted to print 2000 (Two thousand only) pieces of the Special Cover strictly as per the design and specification approved by the competent authority.

b)The sale price of the Special cover should not exceed @ Rs.20/- per piece excluding the cost of the postage stamp(either definitive or commemorative postage stamp) to be affixed on the cover and the amount realized from the sale of those covers will be deposited to the Government Account.

- c) The Special Cover should conform strictly to one of these three sizes: i) 11cm x 22 cm, ii) 13cm x 22 cm & iii) 16cm x 24.3 cm and paper should be Maplithos 120 GSM. The back side of the special cover should contain the logo of Department of Posts and the words "Approved by: the Chief Postmaster General, West Bengal Circle, Department of Posts" (also in Hindi version), with Code No: -WB/10/2021.
- d) Necessary action may be taken as per the existing Rules & Procedures of the Department regarding release of any Special Cover vide "The Handbook on Philately" and instructions issued in this regard time to time. 200 (two hundred) Special Covers may be supplied to the ADG (Philately), Dak Bhawan, New Delhi for sale at e-Post Office, vide Directorate letter under F.No.25-01/2015-Phil dtd. 17.02.2016, circulated through C.O letter under No. MM&PO/RIg/SC/2016 dtd. 22.02.2016 and 26.04.2016 and Directorate letter under No. 25-01/2015-Phil dtd. 14.09.2016 circulated vide C.O letter under No. MM&PO/RIg/SC/2016 dtd. 16.09.2016.

मेहीदाना भारत के पश्चिम बंगाल के बर्दवान जिले की एक भारतीय मिटाई है। मिहीदाना को पारंपरिक बूंदी की एक सूक्ष्म किस्म के रूप में जाना जाता है जो दो शब्दों मिही अर्थात् बारीक तथा दाना अर्थात् अन्न से बना है। इस शब्द का शाब्दिक अर्थ बारीक दाना है। यह मिठाई भौगोलिक संकेत टैग दिया गया। यह अनूठी मिठाई अतिस्वादिष्ट होती है। पश्चिम बंगाल डाक सर्किल इस सुस्वादु मिठाई का उत्सव मनाना गोविंदभोग चावल या कामिनीभोग चावल के आटे से बनाई जाती है जिसमें थोड़ा–सा चने का आटा और सुनहरे रंग के लिए केसर मिलाय जाता है। तत्पश्चात इसमें पानी डालकर हाथ से तब तक मिलाया जाता है जब तक कि इसका रंग हल्का न हो जाए। इस मिश्रण को पितल की झरनी से कढ़ाई में रखे गर्म घी में डालकर भूरे होने तक तला जाता है। अब तले हुए छोटे–छोटे चावल जैसे दाने को चीनी की चासनी में डुबोया जाता है और जब यह चासनी में सराबोर हों जाता है तब इसे छांन लिया जाता है। वर्ष 2017 में भारत सरकार द्वारा "बर्द्धमान मिहीदाना" के वाहता है जिसकी एक झलक से बंगालियों के मुंह में पानी भर आता है।

from two words, Mihi meaning fine, and Dana meaning grain. The word is literally translated to mean fine grains. This dessert is made from powdered Gobindabhog rice or Kaminibhog rice flour, mixed with a small amount of Bengal gram flour and saffron for a golden colour. It is then blended with water by hand till its colour lightens. This mix is then poured through a brass ladle with tiny holes into a pot of ghee and deep-fried. The fine fried small rice-like grains are dipped in sugar syrup and drained once soaked. In 2017, 'Bardhaman Mihidana' was Mihidana is an Indian sweet from Burdwan, West Bengal, India. Mihidana, described as the micro cousin of the traditional Boondi, is derived allotted the geographical indication tag by the Government of India. The exotic sweet is delicious by taste. West Bengal Postal Circle would like to celebrate the essence of this dessert, the sight of which is enough to tantalize a Bengali's taste bud.
