No candidate will be allowed to appear in the test until and unless Aadhaar/School ID (in original) are produced before the centre in charge.

No candidate will be allowed to carry laptops, mobile phone any books and exercise books at the time of examination.

Answer sheets will be provided by the Centre in charge. On the top of the answer sheet candidates should write his/her name, Roll No., Name of the Centre, Name of the School, Class in which he/she is studying. The centre in-charge will make a rubber stamp with the above details, to be inscribed on each answer script, which are to be filled by the candidate in their own handwriting.

The centre in-charge will ensure to send the best three answer sheets (irrespective of languages) to ADPS (BD&Phil), O/o the CPMG, WB Circle, Kolkata-12, which should reach 'CO' within 06.04.2023, with a copy of attendance sheet duly signed by the candidates.

Individual schools can also hold the said competition independently for their students. The students of the school may apply to the school authority. School authority may hold the exam on their own at the school premises on 02.04.2023, with a cut-off date for accepting application on or before 27.03.2023.

After holding the competition, individual schools must send the best three answer sheets (irrespective of languages) with a copy of attendance sheet duly signed by the candidates, & the application form submitted by the candidate so as to reach on or before 05.04.2023, directly to concerned Postal Division (Senior Superintendent of Post Offices / Superintendent of Post Offices) wherein the concerned school exist.

Concerned Divisional heads will ensure to collect the above answer sheets, application form & attendance sheet from school authority and send to ADPS (BD&Phil), O/o the CPMG, WB Circle, Kolkata-12, which should reach 'CO' within 06.04.2023.

The Prize will be awarded to the winners as below: -

## Prizes (at Circle Level)

a. First Prize Rs. 25,000/- and a certificate b. Second Prize Rs. 10,000/- and a certificate c. Third Prize Rs. 5,000/- and a certificate

## Prizes (at National Level)

a. First Prize Rs. 50,000/- and a certificate
b. Second Prize Rs. 25,000/- and a certificate
c. Third Prize Rs. 10,000/- and a certificate

The best entry at the National level shall qualify as the official Indian entry for the International level competition. The UPU shall select the award winning entries. The top winners will receive a special medal (gold for 1st, silver for 2nd & bronze for 3nd) and a certificate and such other prizes decided by the UPU. The Gold medalist may also be offered a trip to the UPU headquarter or some other prize.
